CCU and Enex acquire all remaining shares of their companies in Paraguay

The transactions carried out by both Quiñenco group companies were included as an alternative in the agreements signed a year ago with Sudameris Bank, which decided to exercise its put option on the minority interest it held in Bebidas del Paraguay, Distribuidora del Paraguay and Enex Paraguay.

February 20, 2024.- Sudameris Bank informed CCU and Enex, both entities related to Quiñenco, of its decision to exercise the put option included as an alternative in the agreements signed in March 2023, when the bank became CCU's partner in Bebidas del Paraguay S.A. and in Distribuidora del Paraguay S.A., and Enex's partner in Enex Paraguay S.A.E. Upon Sudameris's decision to exercise its option, that same day CCU and Enex acquired the respective shares, reaching 100% ownership of their respective companies in that country.

In the case of CCU, its interest increased from 55% to 100% of Bebidas del Paraguay and Distribuidora del Paraguay, which commercialize the brands Heineken, Amstel, Sol, Sajonia, La Fuente, Puro Sol, Pulp and Watts in that country. Currently, these two entities have a combined workforce of more than 500 employees.

Enex, in turn, now fully owns Enex Paraguay, which today has over 77 service stations, 37 convenience stores and close to 700 workers.

In addition to disclosing the transactions, CCU and Enex expressed their willingness to continue contributing to Paraguay's development, to the generation of quality jobs, and to continue delivering quality products and services to the country's inhabitants.
